Credo Update

November 2009 to January 2010

We happily report that we have completed phase 1 of our program with **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia** (Faculty of Math and Science Education). Following is an excerpt of a letter from the Dean:

"We have noticed that the courses have increased student soft skills specifically in creative thinking skills and self-confidence which is very essential for prospective teachers. The courses have also revealed that methods to integrate creativity to UPI curriculum need to be seriously well thought out in the very near future."

We will continue to work hard to achieve the vision of a very creative Indonesia. Our collaboration with **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia** and **Universitas Negeri Jakarta** continues and talks are underway to roll out our creative teaching projects in urban poor communities beyond the borders of Jakarta and the major cities. This is an exciting time for creative teaching!

Since November 2009, Credo has:

A. Program Development

1. Started development of the contents for parts 2 and 3 of a 6 credit creativity education course that is being taught at **Universitas Negeri Jakarta** (PAUD – Early Childhood Education).
2. Developed the program contents for phase 2 of a 3 phase training program for urban poor community teachers with the **Urban Poor Consortium**.
3. Developed the contents for phase 2 of a 3 phase *Effective Teaching* program for teacher students at the teacher training center **Edupreneur, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia**.

B. Teaching and Training



Completed a **year long program** with a group of **teachers** in Tangerang in a *Teaching for Creativity* program. 6 teachers involved in this program receive school visits and support from our team of trainers

Continued phase 2 of a 3 phase teacher training project with teachers from the **Urban Poor Consortium**. The training program focuses on designing effective lessons for young children.



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Completed teaching two classes of an accredited creativity education course at **Universitas Negeri Jakarta** (PAUD – Early Childhood Education).

Completed teaching an *Enhancing Personal Creativity* program to biology education and chemistry education students at **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia, Bandung**.



Begun teaching phase 2 of a 3 phase *Effective Teaching* program for teacher students at the teacher training center **Edupreneur, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia**.



Started teaching an *Enhancing Personal Creativity* program to elementary education students at **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia, Serang**.

Completed training a group of teachers in Self-Sufficiency in Teaching Resources and Materials and Designing Effective Lessons. The teachers belong to the network **UPLINK** (Urban Poor Link) and teach in urban poor areas from various cities around Indonesia.



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Completed teaching a *Teaching for Creativity* program to biology education students at **Universitas Negeri Jakarta**.

C. Research

1. Collaborating with **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia** in a research project for **effective teaching methods** with a group of teacher students at the teacher training center **Edupreneur, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia**.
2. Collaborating with the faculty of **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia** (Faculty of Math and Science Education) in a research project for creativity education for teacher students.
3. Conducting research in enhancing personal creativity in teacher students at **Universitas Negeri Jakarta** (PAUD – Early Childhood Education)

D. Teachers' Resource Development & Distribution

1. Developing contents for a web based resource or book for teachers in how teachers can recycle materials to create teaching tools for active learning in the classroom.

E. Income Generation

1. Conducted a workshop for teachers in designing creative learning activities. The workshop was organized by **Edupreneur, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia**.

GOING FORWARD, Credo is:

A. Program Development

1. Developing the contents for phase 3 of a 3 phase *Effective Teaching* program for teacher students at the teacher training center **Edupreneur, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia**.
2. In negotiation with **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia, Serang**, in developing a creative teaching program for lecturers.

B. Teaching and Training

1. Teaching two classes of an accredited creativity education course at **Universitas Negeri Jakarta** (PAUD – Early Childhood Education).
2. Teaching parts 2 and 3 of a 3 part creativity program to biology education and chemistry education students at **Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia, Bandung**.

C. Research

1. Presenting 5 papers at The 17th International Conference on Learning hosted by the Hong Kong Institute of Education in July 2010.

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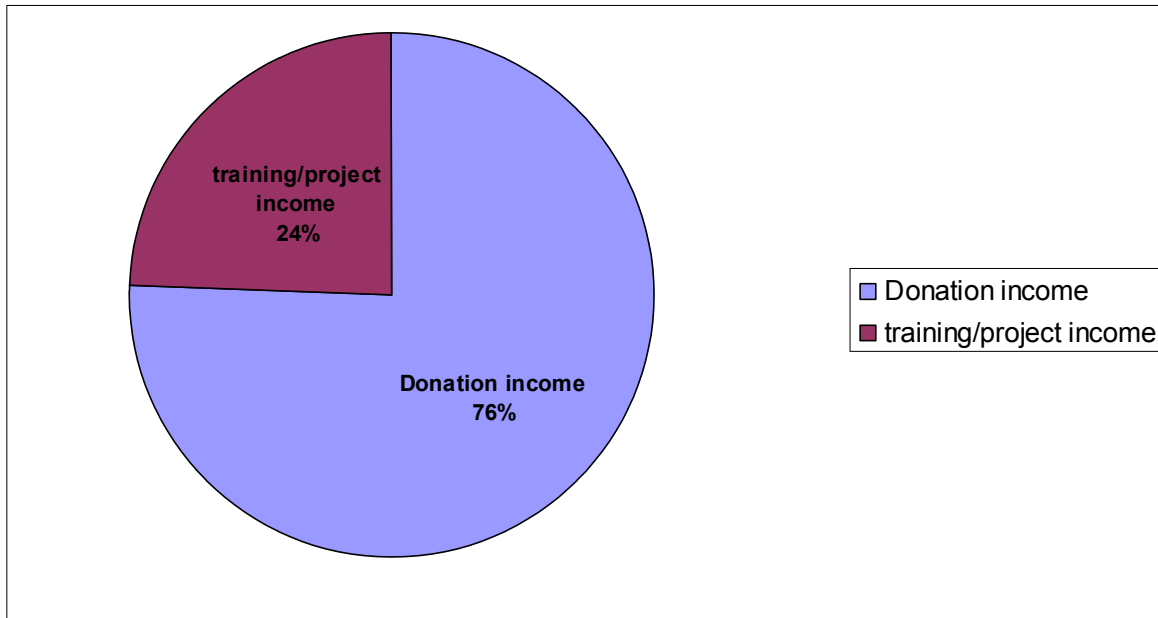
Income and Expenses at a Glance

Period 1 January - 31 December 2009

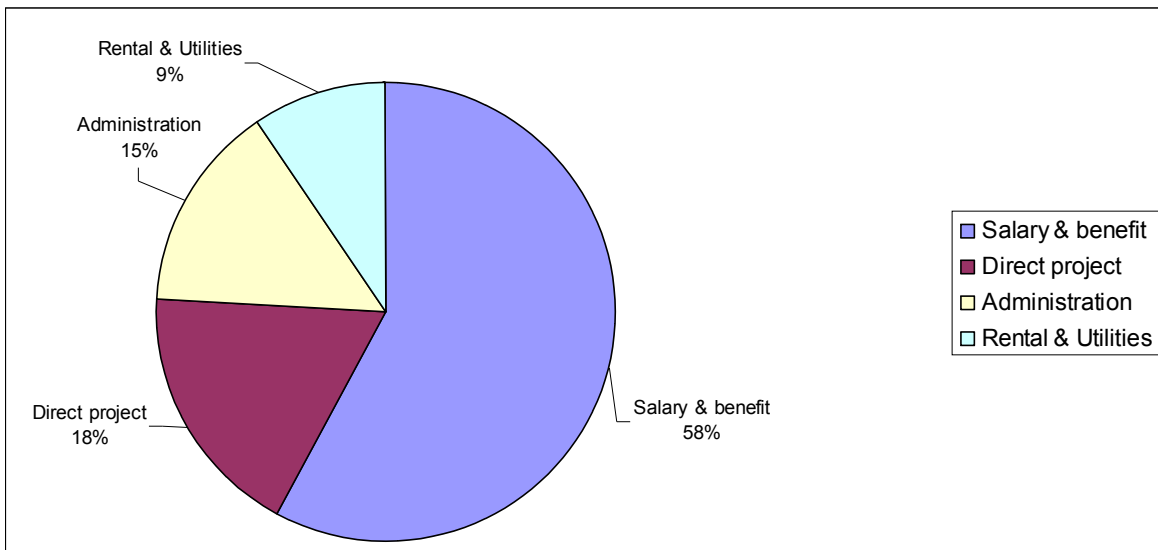
Income Rp 559,606,942.70
